Renditions for Prior Document Versions

The Document Renditions API now allows users to access and manage renditions for prior versions of a document. Users can download, upload, replace, and delete renditions where they have the correct permissions on the document.

New in_migration_v Property in Study Catalog (eTMF)

The Study Catalog API now exposes the *in_migration_v* property. Vault uses this property, alongside the *active_v* property, to enforce licensing limits in eTMF vaults.
